*ORDER REGARDING REMITTITUR*

Appellants have filed a motion to stay issuance of the remittitur. Respondent filed an opposition to the motion and alternatively, requested that if this court is to grant the motion to stay issuance of the remittitur, that this court order appellants to post a \$22,788,048 bond, which respondent alleges covers the amount of damages owed. Appellants have filed a reply in support of the motion. Respondent then filed a "Notice of Filing Letter" containing a copy of a letter from California counsel for appellant Edward William Bayuk, individually and as trustee of the Edward William Bayuk Living Trust regarding satisfaction of a judgment domesticated in California. Appellants move to strike the notice as a fugitive document that has no bearing on the instant appeal.

Having considered the arguments of the parties, this court grants the motion to stay the remittitur in part. Appellants shall have 30 days from the date of this order to file a writ petition in the United States

Supreme Court. Thereafter, the stay of the remittitur will continue on the condition that the writ is filed and appellants post a supersedeas bond in the sum of \$22,788,048 within 30 days of written confirmation from the clerk of the United States Supreme Court to this court that the writ petition has been filed. NRAP 41(b)(3)(C). If appellants do file a petition and post the requisite bond, the stay will continue in effect until final disposition of the certiorari proceedings. If a writ petition is not filed within this time period, the clerk shall issue the remittitur.

The motion to strike the "Notice of Filing of Letter" is granted.  
The clerk of this court shall strike the notice filed on October 31, 2021.

It is so ORDERED.
