ORDER DENYING MOTION

Appellant and cross-appellant The Dr. Miriam and Sheldon G. Adelson Educational Institute (Adelson) has filed a motion requesting a second extension of time to file the combined reply brief on cross-appeal in Docket No. 78341 and reply brief on appeal in Docket No. 79464.
