After considering the pleadings and argument of counsel, the Court GRANTS United Automobile Insurance Company's Motion to Consolidate on Order Shortening Time and DEFERS Defendant/ Third Party Plaintiff Lewis' Countermotion to Set Aside Void Order and to Strike All Filings by Intervenor, or, in the Alternative, for Summary Judgment.

The Court finds that claims in both cases arise from the same car accident and the same issues of law and facts exist in both cases. The Court further finds that decisions made in both cases, as well as the matters currently on appeal, will affect the litigation in both cases and so it is beneficial for the cases to be consolidated. Further, the cases were both being litigated before Department XXIX prior to the cases being reassigned and being placed in separate departments. 
