ORDER

These are consolidated appeals from a judgment after a bench trial and denial of a timely motion to alter or amend and an order awarding attorney fees. It appears that the parties have treated the appeals as an appeal and cross-appeal. Appellant and respondent Athanasios Skarpelos filed an opening brief. Respondents and appellants Weiser Asset Management, Ltd., and Weiser (Bahamas) Ltd. have filed a "Combined Answering and Opening Brief" addressing both the underlying judgment and the award of attorney fees. Under the circumstances, Skarpelos shall have until September 21, 2020, to file and serve a combined brief to reply to Weiser's arguments regarding the judgment and denial of motion for new trial and to answer Weiser's arguments regarding the award of attorney

fees. Weiser shall then have 30 days from the service of that combined brief to file a reply addressing the award of attorney fees, if deemed necessary.
