On January 22, 2018 Alexis Anne Plunkett appeared and advised the Court that she had been in contact with Defendant David Reed recently as well as the public Defender regarding the case and requested that the hearing be continued to February 7, 2018 in order to determine if Defendant David Reed was able to retain her in representing him. Mr. Eric w. Rusley from the Public Defender's office indicated that the trial date is vacated and the calendar call date be used as a status check to determine if Ms. Plunkett would confirm as counsel or the Public Defender would confirm as counsel. Defendant David Reed agreed to vacate the trial date and set a status check date. On February 7, 2019 nothing was resolved; Defendant David Reed indicated that he wanted more time to retain Ms. Plunkett. Ms. Navarro from the Public Defender's office indicated that she would reach out to Ms. Plunkett as a professional courtesy to let Ms. Plunkett know that Deft David Reed wanted to retain her services. Again, Defendant David Reed requested to be remanded to CCDC and I again explained to Defendant David Reed that I could not tell CCDC where to house Defendant David Reed. On March 7, 2018, I noted that Defendant David Reed had been indicted on a new case and that this case in which Defendant David Reed filed a Writ as well as Pre Trial Motions is to be dismissed pursuant to the indictment. Further, the Public Defender was unable to confirm on the new case because of a conflict and Defendant David Reed requested Rochelle Nguyen be appointed who would confirm as counsel at the next date as to the new indictment. On March 14 ,2018, Ms. Derjavina from the Clark County District Attorney's Office advised based on the indictment in case C-18-329762-1, case C-17-327407-1 was being dismissed. Further, the Court ordered that the case C-17-327407-l was dismissed.

FURTHER ORDERED, Oral Motion to Remove current Deputy DENIED. Ms. Derjavina advised she was not present during the Faretta Canvass of Defendant and requested the Court inquire of the Defendant that if convicted Defendant is facing a possible sentence of life in prison based on the notice to seek habitual criminal. Court canvassed Defendant as to the habitual criminal notice and possible statuses. Defendant stated he understands and objected to any habitual criminal notice as he does not believe he is eligible for a habitual criminal sentence. Court informed Defendant it is his right to represent himself and the Court has appointed stand by counsel to assist Defendant; although, the Court would strongly suggest he allow counsel to represent him.
