ORDER GRANTING MOTION

Appellant's motion to extend the supplemental briefing schedule is granted. NRAP 26(b)(1)(A). Appellant shall have until March 1, 2021, to file and serve a supplemental opening brief that does not exceed 10 pages or the equivalent type-volume limitation and a supplemental appendix containing the transcripts of the proceedings conducted in November and December of 2020. Respondent shall have 30 days from service of appellant's supplemental brief to file and serve a supplemental answering brief that does not exceed 10 pages or the equivalent type-volume limitation. Appellant shall have 14 days from service of respondent's supplemental brief to file and serve a supplemental reply brief that does not exceed 5 pages or the equivalent type-volume limitation.
