
*ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR STAY AND
GRANTING IN PART MOTION TO EXPEDITE*

This is an appeal from a district court order granting a motion for a preliminary injunction. Appellants have filed motions to stay the injunction pending appeal. Having considered the motions, opposition, and documents before this court, this court is not convinced that a stay is warranted at this time. Accordingly, the motion is denied. This denial is without prejudice to appellants' ability to renew the motion should the State of Nevada Department of Taxation decline to further extend the June 5, 2020, deadline to receive final inspections pursuant to NAC 453D.295.

Appellant Nevada Organic Remedies, LLC (NOR) has also filed a motion to expedite the briefing and disposition of this appeal. All respondents but the State of Nevada Department of Taxation oppose the motion. The request to set an expedited briefing schedule is denied. However, appellants may file their opening and reply briefs earlier than their deadlines should they wish to shorten the total briefing time in this matter. Due to the nature of the issues involved in this matter, requests for extensions of time to file briefs will not be viewed favorably and will not be granted absent extraordinary and compelling circumstances. NOR's request to expedite review of this appeal is granted. This court will expedite a disposition of this matter once briefing is completed.

It is so ORDERED.
