## RESPONSE OF NEVADA ORGANIC REMEDIES, LLC TO ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On April 3, 2020, this Court issued a second Order to Show Cause as to the Court's jurisdiction in Docket Nos. 79670, 79671, 79672, and 79673. The Court directed appellants to show cause as to this Court's jurisdiction over these appeals. NOR is only a party to the appeal in Docket No. 79670, and its response to the Order to Show Cause applies only to that case.

The subject of all of the appeals mentioned in the Order to Show Cause (as well as the appeals in Docket Nos. 79668 and 79669) is a single order granting a preliminary injunction in Department XI of the Eighth Judicial District Court. Although Department XI only included the Plaintiffs from district court case No. A-19-787004-B (which are the Respondents in Docket No. 79668) in its original order granting the preliminary injunction and later amended its order to add the Plaintiffs from district court case No. A-19-786962-B (which are the Respondents in Docket No. 79669), the Plaintiffs in district court case No. A-18-785818-W (which are the Respondents in Docket No. 79670) participated in the briefing and the hearing on the motion for preliminary injunction. NOR filed the appeal against those latter Plaintiffs out of an abundance of caution as NOR was unsure at the time of filing the notices of appeal whether those Plaintiffs were actually parties to the preliminary injunction order.

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After further review, NOR now agrees with this Court that the district court did not enter the order granting preliminary injunction in district court case No. A-18-785818-W, because it did not have jurisdiction over that case at the time it granted the preliminary injunction. NOR's appeal in Docket No. 79670 should, therefore, be dismissed, and NOR asks that the appeal be dismissed as unappealable.
