ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS

Court recorder Brittany Amoroso has filed a motion for an extension of time to prepare the transcripts requested in this appeal. The motion is granted. See NRAP 9(c)(4). Ms. Amoroso shall have until March 16, 2020, to file the requested transcripts in the district court and deliver copies to the requesting party. See NRAP 9(c)(1)(A). Ms. Amoroso shall have until March 23, 2020, to file a notice with this court that the completed transcripts have been filed and delivered. The notice must comply with NRAP 9(c)(2). Failure to comply with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions. NRAP 9(c)(5), NRAP 13.

The motion for an extension of time to file the opening brief is granted. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). Appellant shall have until April 28, 2020, to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. Given the length of this initial extension request, no further extensions shall be permitted absent extraordinary circumstances and extreme need. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). Counsel's caseload normally will not be deemed such a circumstance. *Cf. Varnum v. Grady*, 90 Nev. 374, 528 P.2d 1027 (1974). Failure to timely file the opening brief and appendix may result in the imposition of sanctions.

It is so ORDERED.
