Provide a brief description of the nature of the Action and result in the district court, including the type of judgment or order being appealed and the relief granted by the district court: Petitioner, Craig Tiffee had done everything required to warrant having his record sealed for his felony conviction. He successfully completed probation and therefore could withdraw his plea to the higher felony and enter a plea to a felony that did not require that he register as a sex offender. His Petition to seal his record was denied.

However, given the new statutory scheme enacted in 2017 that, among other things, changed the burden of proof onto the state to prove that a defendant should not have his record sealed if they had met all the stated requirements. Petitioner believes that the Court, with all due respect, failed to consider the changes in the records sealing law in rendering its decision. The State failed to offer any relevant evidence to prove that Petitioner should not have his record sealed given that he met all the requirements necessary.

In addition, the State relied on the nature of the charge that Petitioner could withdraw his plea from as opposed to the lower charge that was and is still on his record. It is our contention that the Nevada Legislature already considered the nature of the specific charge that a defendant is seeking to seal as a result of specifically listing the felonies that can and can't be sealed after all the requirements are successfully completed. As such, in order to show that a Petitioner should not have his record sealed, the State must point to other factors in arguing a case should not be sealed.
