O R D E R

The motion of respondents Teld, LLC, Peter Eliades, Individually and as Trustee of the Eliadas Survivor Trust of 10/30/08, and Eldorado Hills, LLC to exceed the type-volume limitation of NRAP 32(a)(7)(A)(ii) is granted. NRAP 32(a)(7)(D). The clerk shall detach the answering brief and the appendix from the motion filed on November 24, 2021, and file them separately.

Respondents/cross-appellants Sig Rogich, A/K/A Sigmund Rogich, Individually, and as Trustee of the Rogich Family Irrevocable Trust and Imitations, LLC (Rogich parties) filed their combined answering brief on appeal and opening brief on cross-appeal on November 24, 2021. The brief was inadvertently filed by the clerk of this court as it is not compliant with this court's formatting rules. *See* NRAP 32(e) ("If a brief . . . is not prepared in accordance with [NRAP 32] the clerk will not file the document, but shall return it to be properly prepared."). Specifically, the brief does not have margins of at least 1-inch on all four sides, *see* NRAP 32(a)(4), the page-numbering does not comply with the requirements of NRAP 32(a)(4), and the certificate of compliance does not contain all certifications required by NRAP 32(a)(9). Accordingly, the clerk shall strike the Rogich parties' brief filed on November 24, 2021. The Rogich parties shall have 7 days from the date of this order to file and serve a corrected combined brief. Failure to timely comply with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions,

including the dismissal of the Rogich parties' cross-appeal and/or disposition of the appeal without an answering brief from the Rogich parties. NRAP 31(d).

It is so ORDERED.
