*ORDER SCHEDULING ORAL ARGUMENT*

This matter is scheduled for oral argument on September 29, 2020, at 1:30 p.m. Argument shall be limited to 30 minutes. Oral argument will be held in Las Vegas or by videoconference, depending on current public health conditions.<sup>1</sup> The Clerk of the Court will notify the parties by September 15, 2020, as to whether the argument will be in person or conducted via videoconference.

On or before August 10, the parties shall submit to the Clerk of the Court a notice identifying the attorney(s) who will argue the case and the landline and cellular phone numbers and email address of that attorney(s).
