***ORDER DIRECTING SUPPLEMENTAL BRIEFING
AND INVITING AMICUS BRIEFING***


Having granted the petition for review in this matter, and after reviewing the documents filed in this appeal, this court has concluded that supplemental briefing will be of assistance. Accordingly, appellant Henry Biderman Aparicio shall have 30 days from the date of this order to file and serve a supplemental brief addressing the questions presented for review regarding a district court's ability to review letters received prior to, or at the time of, the sentencing hearing. . NRAP 40B(g). Respondent State of Nevada shall file and serve a supplemental answering brief within 30 days after Aparicio's brief is served. Aparicio shall then have 15 days after the State's supplemental answering brief is served to file and serve any supplemental reply brief. Briefing shall comply with the relevant provisions of NRAP 28 and 32, and the parties may cite to either the record on appeal or any appendices submitted with the briefs.


Further, this court has determined that amicus briefing may be helpful to this court's consideration and resolution of this appeal. Therefore, the Nevada Attorney General's Office, Nevada Attorneys for Criminal Justice, Nevada District Attorney's Association, Clark County

Public Defender's Office, and Washoe County Public Defender's Office are invited to submit amicus briefs addressing the questions raised on review regarding a district court's ability to review letters received prior to, or at the time of, the sentencing hearing. Any amicus brief must be filed within 7 days from the filing of the party's supplemental brief being supported by the amicus curiae. See NRAP 29(f). The brief shall not exceed 10 pages and shall otherwise comply with the requirements of NRAP 32(a)(4)-(6).
