1 **MEMORANDUM**

2 I, NANCY A. BECKER, am the supervising attorney in the above-captioned case. The
3 State's Answering Brief is currently due on April 25, 2011. The State is requesting a THIRTY
4 (30) day extension of time in which to file its Answering Brief, making it due on May 25, 2011.
5 Pursuant to NRAP 31(b)(3), this Court for good cause shown can enlarge the time prescribed by
6 the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure for the filing of an Answering Brief. As good cause
7 for the extension in the instant case, the State cites the complexity of the issues presented. In
8 particular, Appellant has raised a complex issue concerning redundancy and double jeopardy
9 with regards to multiple counts of sexual assault. The State needs additional time to properly
10 research and brief this issue. Moreover, Appellant has also raised several claims of prosecutorial
11 misconduct, and the trial prosecutor requires additional time to review the briefing on this issue.

12 The certificate of service in Appellant's Opening Brief is dated February 22, 2011.
13 Appellant's Opening Brief is twenty (20) pages in length and raises issues and sub-issues
14 covering complex questions of trial court procedure and alleges instances of judicial error that
15 require a thorough review of the record. Appellant's Notice of Appeal was filed on February 22,
16 2010. Based on the foregoing, the State requires an additional THIRTY (30) days to fully
17 respond to this appeal. This is the State's second Motion for an Extension of Time in this matter.
18 Appellant was granted extensions of time on June 22, 2010, October 8, 2010, and December 13,
19 2010.
