RESPONDENT BAHRAM YAHYAVI'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANSWERING BRIEF

Respondent Bahram Yahyavi, by and through his counsel of record, Dennis M. Prince and Kevin T. Strong of PRINCE LAW GROUP, hereby moves to extend the time to file his Answering Brief by thirty (30) days, up to and including Wednesday, November 11, 2020, pursuant to NRAP 31(b)(3).
