ORDER GRANTING MOTION AND REDESIGNATING APPEAL

This is an appeal from an order denying appellant's motion to modify his sentence. Appellant pleaded guilty to grand larceny, a category C felony, and possession of burglary tools, a gross misdemeanor. Appellant has filed a motion to transfer this appeal to the court's NRAP 3C fast track, explaining that he is only challenging the sentence for the gross misdemeanor. Cause appearing, the motion is granted. See NRAP 3C(a)(2), (3). The clerk of this court shall transfer this appeal to the court's fast track program. Appellant shall have 40 days from the date of this order to file and serve a fast track statement and appendix. Thereafter, briefing shall proceed in accordance with NRAP 3C(e) and (f).
