Glenn Miller Doolin was charged by way of Information with Grand Larceny Auto filed September 17, 2012, for the theft of a motor scooter. An Amended Information was filed November 6, 2012 charging Doolin with Grand Larceny Auto and Possession of Burglary Tools, for the screwdriver he used to start the motor scooter he stole. He entered a plea of guilty to both counts without a negotiation. Pursuant to the Judgment of Conviction filed April 26, 2013, he was adjudged guilty of Count 1, Grand Larceny Auto (Category C Felony) and sentenced under the Small Habitual Statute. Mr. Doolin was also adjudged guilty of Count 2, Possession of Burglary Tools (Gross Misdemeanor).

Doolin was sentenced to 60-150 months in the Nevada Department of Corrections for Count 1 (to run consecutive to Cases C283685 and C262611); and 12 months in the Clark County Detention Center for Count 2 (to run consecutive to Count 1) with zero days credit for time served.

After serving approximately seven years in prison, Mr. Doolin filed a Motion to Modify Sentence on October 10th, 2019. In said motion, Mr. Doolin requested that the consecutive gross misdemeanor sentence be modified to informal probation as he was already going to be supervised by Parole and Probation upon his release from prison. Moreover, Mr. Doolin had both a job and housing lined-up as well as a record of success in prison during the last seven years of incarceration.

At the time the Motion for Modification of Sentence was filed, Mr. Doolin had yet to serve a day on the gross misdemeanor which ran consecutive to the prison sentence he was imminently about to expire. Moreover, statutory authority precluded Mr. Doolin from serving

any time on the imposed gross misdemeanor in the Nevada Department of Corrections where he has been housed since sentencing. The State opposed the motion and on November 6, 2019, the Court denied the motion agreeing with the State that the Court did not have the ability to modify Defendant's sentence as he had already started serving his sentence when the judgment of conviction was issued in the case. The Order denying Doolin's Motion was filed November 18, 2019. A Notice of Appeal was filed December 9, 2019 and docketed in the Nevada Supreme Court under case number 80223.

Counsel for Doolin reviewed the Order prepared by the State as well as the transcript of the hearing; and thereafter contacted the State to correct the order as it did not reflect what occurred in Court nor did its production comport with the Court's order. The State advised the defense to file a motion requesting the Court amend the order. A Motion was filed on January 23, 2020 and the State filed their response on January 29, 2020. While the motion was filed under Order Shortening Time, the Court set the hearing for February 5, 2020, almost 2 weeks from the filing of the Motion. The Court granted the motion on February 5, 2020; and an Amended Order Denying Defendant's Motion to Modify Sentence was filed in open court at the hearing on February 5th. This supplemental appeal follows.
