ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS

The motion for an extension of time to file the combined brief is granted. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). Respondents/cross-appellants shall have until January 11, 2021, to file and serve the combined answering brief on appeal and opening brief on cross-appeal. Given the length of this initial extension request, no further extensions shall be permitted absent extraordinary circumstances and extreme need. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). Counsel's caseload normally will not be deemed such a circumstance. *Cf. Varum v. Grady*, 90 Nev. 374, 528 P.2d 1027 (1974).

Respondents' motion to transmit an original exhibit is granted. NRAP 30(d). The clerk of the district court shall have 14 days from the date of this order to transmit to this court Trial Exhibit 10. If the district court

clerk is unable to transmit this exhibit, he shall so notify this court in writing within the same time period.
