23	THE COURT: But what's the purpose if it's not offered for
24	the truth of the matter? What's the purpose
25	MR. HELMICK: That he had knowledge that Matt was

1	calling up Jaiden and Kody to come over.

16	because	that, quote: He wasn't all there.
17		Do you remember saying something like that?
18	А	Yes.
19	Q	In other words, he wasn't fully engaged.
20	А	Correct.
21	Q	Okay. Now, you said that you noticed there was a bag of
22	Xanax	
23	А	Correct.
24	Q	correct?
25		Did you notice who brought the Xanax?

1	Α	No.
2	Q	No. Approximately how many Xanax were in the bag?
3	А	I don't know.
4	Q	Was it a little? A lot?
5	А	It was a sandwich Ziploc. It was about I guess you could
6	say it wa	as about halfway full.
7	Q	So it's a sandwich bag, like a baggie?
8	А	Correct.
9	Q	And you said it was about halfway full?
10	Α	Correct.
11	Q	Okay. And you saw Matthew take some Xanax?
12	Α	Correct.
13	Q	You saw Jaiden take some Xanax?
14	Α	Yes.
15	Q	And you saw Kody take some Xanax?
16	Α	Yes.
17	Q	And in relation to the time that Jaiden shot Matthew, how
18	long bef	fore that did they take the Xanax?
19	Α	I'm not too sure.
20	Q	I mean, was it an hour before? A minute before?
21	Somew	here in between?
22	Α	It had to have been within the hour.
23	Q	It had within the hour.
24	Α	Yes.
25	Q	Okay. Now when the video was played, Kody was

22	time pur	poses, Matt was already obviously at the house and Jaider
23	was thei	re, you were there, and you guys were already smoking
24	weed an	d drinking, correct?
25	_	Correct

1	Q	And at that point in time, Matt and Jaiden and Kody had
2	already	come back with that bag of Xanax.
3	А	Yes.
4	Q	Okay. So do you recall if any of that Xanax was taken
5	before	that shot was fired into the ceiling?
6	Α	I'm not aware that anyone had taken any prior.
7	Q	Okay.
8	Α	I just noticed that there was a big bag of pills after they all
9	had car	ne back.
10	Q	Okay. So when they came back, the shot into the ceiling
11	happen	ed, correct?
12	Α	Yes.
13	Q	So you're not familiar exactly what time they started
14	taking the Xanax when they got back?	
15	А	I don't recall.
16	Q	Okay. But is it fair to say and we can play the video.

19	Q	So you said that you believed originally that Matt and
20	Kody and Jaiden had come back to the house around 1:00?	
21	Α	Yes.
22	Q	So it would have been the afternoon?
23	Α	Yes.
24	Q	Do you recall that when you fled the house after Matt
25	was sho	ot, do you recall if it was still light out?

1	Α	Yes.
2	Q	It was still light out. Okay.
3		Do you recall around what time that was?
4	А	It was really hot so it may have been during the middle of
5	the day	and possibly 4:00ish.
6	Q	Okay. So it's your estimation that within a at least a few
7	hours o	f this happening is when Matt Minkler was shot.

11	Q	Okay. So let's say afternoon, at least. Was it afternoon on
12	June th	e 8th? 12:00, noon?

14	Q	Okay. Before?
15	А	It was before 5:00, but between the hours of 12:00 and

17	Q	Okay. So between 12:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. you received
18	some s	ort of communication by Charles and/or Alaric?
19	А	Yes.
20	Q	All right. Was some of that over social media?
21	Α	Yes.
22	Q	All right. Was any of the communication actual old school
23	telepho	ne call, person to person?
24	Α	Yes.
25	Q	Okay. And then was there anything that was maybe

1	FaceTin	ne or some other medium like that?
2	А	Yes.
3	Q	Okay. And again, without saying what they said, did they
4	relay in	formation to you about what had happened at that house?
5	А	Yes.
6	Q	Okay. During the course of one of these conversations,

14		MR. YAMPOLSKY: Objection, that calls for speculation.		
15		THE COURT: Well I'll sustain the objection.		
16	BY MS.	OVERLY:		
17	Q	So did that did Matt threaten Jaiden shortly after the		
18	shot to the ceiling?			
19	Α	Yeah.		
20	Q	And when he was threatening Jaiden, what was he doing		
21	with the gun?			
22	Α	Pointing it at him.		
23	Q	Okay. And what happened after that?		
24	А	We just got back to what we was doing.		
25	0	Okay And when you say you got back to what you were		

1	doing, did you all just continue to smoke and drink?		
2	А	Yeah.	
3	Q	And Matt stayed?	
4	А	Yeah.	
5	Q	So at some point in time, did anybody take Xanax?	
6	А	Yeah.	
7	Q	And when did that start happening?	
8	А	I think when Matthew came.	
9	Q	Okay. So some time after Matthew came, you guys

12	Q	Do you know who took it?	
13	Α	Everybody.	
14	Q	Everybody?	
15	Α	Well, I don't know about everybody, but I know I did.	
16	Q	Okay. So how soon after when Matt came back did you	
17	take the Xanax?		
18	Α	Probably like five minutes.	
19	Q	Okay. And how long after you took the Xanax did the	
20	shot to the ceiling happen?		
21	Α	Which I don't recall.	
22	Q	Okay. So after the shot to the ceiling and Matt threatens	
23	Jaiden,	what happened after that? What did you do?	
24	А	What did I do personally?	
25	Q	Uh-huh.	

1	Α	I just went back on the couch.
2	Q	And at some point, did you hear a second shot?
3	Α	Yeah.
4	Q	And when was that?
5	А	Well I was sleeping, and I heard it and then I just woke up.
6	Q	Okay. When you say you were sleeping, where were you
7	sleeping	?
8	Α	Same place you guys showed the video.
9	Q	Okay. So going back to State's 87.
10		Were you sleeping in this area?
11	А	Do I got to point?
12	Q	Sure, you can show us.

14	Q	So kind of at the corner of the L-shape of the couch?
15	Α	Yeah.
16	Q	Okay. And was anyone else on the couch with you?
17	Α	Kody.
18	Q	And what was Kody doing?
19	А	Sleep.
20	Q	Okay. And anyone else?
21	А	Alaric, but he wasn't on the couch.
22	Q	Where was Alaric?
23	А	He was like more over here.
24	Q	He was kind of at the end of the couch, closer to the
25	kitchen?	

1	Α	Yeah. Standing up.
2	Q	Okay. And you hear this shot and what did you do?
3	А	I woke up, saw what happened well I didn't see what
4	happen	, I see like the outcome and I'm like oh, shit and I left.
5	Q	Okay. So I'm going to show you State's Exhibit 84 again.
6	When y	ou say you woke up and you saw the outcome, what did
7	you see	?
8	А	Matthew's body right there, right on the floor.
9	Q	Can you point in the area?
10	А	[No audible response - marking on monitor].
11	Q	Okay. So kind of where the bloody towel is
12	А	Yeah.
13	Q	on the ground.
14		And so you said Matt was on the floor?
15	Α	Yeah.
16	Q	Where was Jaiden?
17	Α	I don't know.
18	Q	You don't know.
19	Α	No.
20	Q	So what did you do?
21	Α	I left.
22	Q	And how'd you leave?
23	Α	Through the back.
24	Q	And why did you leave?
25	Α	I was scared.

1	Q	Scared of what?
2	А	I don't know? I was just in the moment, you know, I was
3	shocked	l, so I was like oh so I left.
4	Q	And did you hear Jaiden say anything?
5	А	No.
6	Q	What about anyone else?
7	Α	No. Well, like I said they was shocked too, so they was

19	Q	Okay. So after this happened, did you see any posts from
20	Jaiden o	n Snapchat about what happened in the house?
21	Α	Yeah.
22	Q	Okay.
23		MS. OVERLY: I'll pass the witness, Your Honor.
24		THE COURT: Thank you.
25		Mr. Helmick?

1		MR. HELMICK: Thank you, Your Honor, but we don't have
2	any que	stions.
3		THE COURT: Mr. Yampolsky?
4		CROSS-EXAMINATION
5	BY MR.	YAMPOLSKY:
6	Q	Mr. Osurman, you said that Kody was sleeping on the
7	couch	
8	А	Yup.
9	Q	next to you.
10		You saw the video where he had the gun in his hand and
11	it was fla	ashing?
12	Α	Yeah.
13	Q	Okay. Obviously, he wasn't sleeping at that time.
14	Α	No.
15	Q	And you said Matthew threatened Jaiden.
16	Α	Yup.
17	Q	And you said he threatened Jaiden and he pointed the
18	gun at h	im.
19	Α	Yup.
20	Q	Did he say anything when he pointed the gun at him?
21	Α	Who, Jaiden?
22	Q	Did Matthew say anything to Jaiden?
23	Α	Yeah.
24	Q	What did he say?
25	А	I mean, didn't you just hear? Oh, no my I'm sorry. He

1	said fuck. You're lucky you're my friend or else I would have
2	blown your head off. You know, shot you or something.
3	MR. YAMPOLSKY: I have nothing further.
4	THE COURT: Ms. Overly.
5	MS. OVERLY: Nothing, Your Honor.
6	THE COURT: Anything from our jurors?
7	Yes.
8	[Bench conference transcribed as follows.]
9	MR. HELMICK: I'm okay with that.
10	MR. PESCI: No objection from the State.

11		THE COURT: Can we show
12		MS. OVERLY: Sure.
13		THE COURT: that photograph again. And I apologize, I
14	forgot tl	ne exhibit number.
15		THE WITNESS: And that's when he first shot?
16		THE COURT: Yeah.
17		MS. OVERLY: This would be 87.
18		THE COURT: Hold on one second.
19		Okay. Thank you.
20	BY THE	COURT:
21	Q	Do you know where Matt was in this area or the kitchen
22	off the p	photograph when the shot was fired? The first shot?
23	А	Yeah, he was in the kitchen.
24	Q	He was in the kitchen area?
25	Α	Yeah.

1	Q	Okay. And then do you know if Matt was near Jaiden
2	when th	nat shot that went into the ceiling occurred?
3	А	Like what you mean?
4	Q	Yeah. I guess the best way to ask it. You told us where
5	you bel	ieve Matt was. Where do you believe Jaiden was when the
6	shot int	o the ceiling occurred?
7	А	Like I said, either right here
8	Q	Okay.
9	А	or over here.
10	Q	Okay. So he could have either been seated in that chair
11	А	Either or.
12	Q	or closer into the kitchen
13	А	Yeah.
14	Q	correct?
15		Okay.
16		THE COURT: Ms. Overly, you have any questions based
17	on mine	e?
18		MS. OVERLY: Just briefly, Your Honor.
9		FOLLOW-UP EXAMINATION
20	BY MS.	OVERLY:
21	Q	So Charles, I believe you said that Matt was in the kitchen
22	area wh	nen Jaiden shot into the ceiling. So showing you Exhibit 84.
23	Can you	u identify the area that Matt was standing in?
24	А	Right here by the sink.
25	Q	Okay. And was he the closest person to Jaiden when

1	Jaiden shot in the ceiling?	
2	А	Like right where he shot?
3	Q	Was he closest in proximity to Jaiden
4	А	Oh, yeah.
5	Q	when Jaiden shot?
6	А	Yeah.
7	Q	Okay.
8	А	There was a whole bunch of people next to him.
9	Q	Next to Jaiden?
10	А	Yeah, he was standing up.
11		MS. OVERLY: I'll pass the witness, Your Honor.
12		THE COURT: Mr. Helmick, anything?
13		MR. HELMICK: No, Your Honor.
14		THE COURT: Mr. Yampolsky?
15		MR. YAMPOLSKY: Yes.
16		FOLLOW-UP EXAMINATION
17	BY MR.	YAMPOLSKY:
18	Q	When you heard the first shot, how long I mean
19	when	after you took the Xanax, how long after did the first shot
20	was the	first shot?
21	Α	I don't know?
22	Q	But you took the Xanax first?
23	Α	Yeah.
24		MR. YAMPOLSKY: That's all I have, Your Honor.
25		THE COURT: Sarah, anything?

1		MS. OVERLY: No, Your Honor.
2		THE COURT: All right. Mr. Osurman, thank you much for

4		The State may call their next witness.
5		MR. PESCI: The State calls Detective Nathan Calvano.
6		MR. OSURMAN: 3:30.
7		MS. OVERLY: What did he say?
8		THE MARSHAL: Can I get that witnesses name again,

10		MR. PESCI: Nathan Calvano. Detective Nathan Calvano.
11		NATHAN CALVANO
12	[hav	ing been called as a witness and being first duly sworn,
13		testified as follows:]
14		THE CLERK: Thank you, please be seated.
15		THE WITNESS: Thank you.
16		THE CLERK: If you could state and spell your name for
17	the recor	d.
18		THE WITNESS: Nathan, N-A-T-H-A-N. Last is Calvano, C,
19	as in Cha	arlie, A-L-V, as in Victor, A-N-O.
20		THE COURT: Thank you, sir.
21		All right. You can go ahead.
22		MR. PESCI: Thank you, Your Honor.
23		DIRECT EXAMINATION
24	BY MR. F	PESCI:
25	Q	Sir, what do you do for a living?

1	Α	I'm a police officer with the City of Henderson.	
2	Q	How long have you been with the Henderson Police	
3	Department?		
4	Α	A little over 13 years.	
5	Q	And where are you currently assigned within the	
6	departr	ment?	
7	Α	I'm assigned to the Robbery/Homicide unit.	
8	Q	In June of 2018, were you in that same unit?	
9	А	Yes, sir.	
10	Q	Specifically on June 8th of 2018, did you respond to the	
11	interse	ction shown in State's 1 of Sunset and North Green Valley	
12	Parkwa	y?	
13	А	I did.	
14	Q	Was there an automobile accident there?	
15	А	Yes, sir.	
16	Q	Showing you State's Exhibit 9. Is that near Sunset?	
17		And State's Exhibit 10, in Green Valley?	
18	А	That is correct.	
19	Q	And specifically in State's 12, does it show the car	
20	accident where the cars were located afterwards?		
21	А	It does.	
22	Q	Did you respond to this scene?	
23	А	I did.	
24	Q	Originally, did patrol handle this.	
25	Α	Yes, sir.	

1	Q	Now without saying what you were told, did you receive
2	informa	tion that made a homicide detective get involved?
3	А	Yes.
4	Q	Based on that, did you respond to this traffic accident
5	area?	
6	А	Yes, sir.
7	Q	Okay. In the course of your investigation, looking at
8	State's	Exhibit 2, did the area of the apartments at the Villas at the
9	Green b	pecome a subject of your investigation?
10	Α	It did.
11	Q	Did you, after responding to the crash scene, go to the
12	Villas scene?	
13	Α	On that day, no.
14	Q	Okay. Later on.
15	А	Yes.
16	Q	Okay. Were you involved with the execution of a search
17	warrant	?
18	А	I was.
19	Q	And when I say that I mean after a search warrant's
20	obtaine	d from a Judge, giving you permission to search, were you
21	involve	d in the actual search of those areas that the search warrant
22	told you	u, you could search?
23	А	Yes, sir.
24	Q	Okay. And specifically looking at State's Exhibit 49.
25		The car that we saw earlier at the crash scene, the

1	Mercede	es, was it brought back to the Henderson Crime Lab?
2	Α	It was.
3	Q	And then with the search warrant, was a search
4	conduct	ed a further search, of the challenge back at the lab?
5	Α	Yes, sir.
6	Q	All right. What's the rationale of taking it back to the lab,
7	as oppo	sed to staying in the middle of an intersection?
8	Α	Well at the time once the search warrant was obtained,
9	it's dark	outside, it's difficult to see. It's also more of a sterile
10	environi	ment when we bring it back.
11	Q	All right. How do you know you were a part of this
12	search?	
13	Α	That's actually me standing in the background.
14	Q	All right. So this is you depicted in State's 49?
15	Α	Correct.
16	Q	All right. So as you're there, is there a crime scene
17	analyst	that's taking the photographs?
18	Α	There is.
19	Q	And is do you work in conjunction with the crime scene
20	analyst	as far as what you're looking at, what's photographed, and
21	what's i	mpounded?
22	Α	I do.
23	Q	And in this case, State's 50, does that show the damage to
24	the other side of that vehicle?	
25	Α	Yes, sir.

1	Q	That's how we know we're dealing with the same car in	
2	State's	51, we have the license plate, which is the same from the	
3	car or c	car or crash scene?	
4	Α	That's correct.	
5	Q	All right. Inside of this vehicle, was there a wallet from	
6	the vict	im, Matthew Minkler found?	
7	Α	There was.	
8	Q	Showing you State's Exhibit 52.	
9		Is that that photograph?	
10	Α	That is.	
11	Q	Now inside of the wallet, was or I should say was the	
12	identification inside of the wallet?		
13	А	Yes, sir.	
14	Q	All right. So is this photograph taken to depict what was	
15	inside and taken out to show what it was?		
16	Α	The contents of the wallet, yes.	
17	Q	All right. Speaking of the contents, State's 53, is that a	
18	close-up of Matthew?		
19	А	It is.	
20	Q	Okay. Was anything else found inside of that wallet?	
21	А	No, sir.	
22	Q	Any cash?	
23	А	No, sir.	
24	Q	Were other items found inside of that wallet that became	
25	of interest to you or things that you thought you might want to		

1	follow up on?		
2	А	Particularly in the wallet, no.	
3	Q	And I apologize, I should have said the car. I'm sorry.	
4	А	Yes, sir.	
5	Q	Showing you State's Exhibit 60.	
6		Was the trunk of that car searched?	
7	А	Yes, it was.	
8	Q	Okay. And then what's that long piece of paper on top of	
9	what ap	pears to be a bag?	
10	А	That is a receipt.	
11	Q	Okay. Did you look into that receipt? Let me specifically	
12	show yo	ou State's 64. Is that well, that's not [indiscernible]	
13	picture,	but is that that receipt a little further up close?	
14	Α	It is.	
15	Q	And in State's 65. Is that a little better?	
16	Α	Yes, sir.	
17	Q	All right. What information did you have from the	
18	receipt?		
19	Α	So it's a receipt from Foot Locker. The address is the	
20	Galleria Mall. It has a date and a time listed at the top of it, an item		
21	that was	s purchased, and then what was used, as far as monetarily,	
22	to purch	ase that item.	
23	Q	Okay. So did you look in the car based on that receipt to	
24	see if th	see if the very item that was purchased might have been in the car	
25	Α	I did.	

1	Q	All right. Showing you State's Exhibit 66.
	<u> </u>	
2		Did you find what you thought was in fact that time that
3	was pur	chased?
4	Α	Yes, sir.
5	Q	And then looking at State's 67.
6		Does that show the exact, I don't know if the right term is
7	make ar	nd model, but the specifics of the sneaker?
8	Α	Yes, sir.
9	Q	Okay. And did you look at those when they were taken
10	out in S	tate's 68?
11	А	I did.
12	Q	All right. And did that match up the information that you
13	saw on	the receipt?
14	А	It did.
15	Q	Okay. So based on that information, what, if anything, did
16	you do?	
17	Α	The next thing I did was went over and made contact with
18	Foot Loc	cker.
19	Q	Okay. When you say you made contact with Foot Locker,
20	do you r	mean did you go to the Galleria Mall?
21	А	I did.
22	Q	Okay. And what was the purpose of you going to the
23	Galleria	Mall?
24	А	In order to obtain the transaction information, as well as
25	any vide	eo surveillance footage of the purchase.

1	Q	Okay. Before we get there, I apologize, I forgot to ask you
2	a coupl	e other things.
3		The search warrant we just spoke of, that was of the car
4	out at tl	ne crash scene, correct?
5	А	Correct.
6	Q	Did you also participate or were you a part of the search
7	warrant	done at the house on Cool Lilac?
8	А	I was.
9	Q	And were you familiar showing you State's Exhibit 77.
10	Is that t	he house where the search warrant was conducted?
11	А	Yes, that's the back of it.
12	Q	And much like we just spoke of with the car, were you
13	present	when crime scene analysts took photographs and
14	impoun	ded evidence?
15	А	Yes, sir.
16	Q	All right. And then from the car, were two iPhones
17	obtaine	d?
18	А	Yes.
19	Q	And were they impounded into evidence?
20	А	They were.
21	Q	And at this particular scene, was there a different phone
22	that was found?	
23	А	Correct. A non-iPhone.
24	Q	And the non-iPhone, where was that found?
25	Α	That was found on the decedent inside of the closet.

1	Q	Okay. And then was that also impounded to be able to be
2	looked a	at later?
3	Α	It was.
4	Q	Okay. Now circling back to the Galleria Mall. When you
5	went to	the mall, you talked about Foot Locker. Did you make
6	contact	with somebody at Foot Locker?
7	А	I did.
8	Q	And did you ask to try to or what did you do? What did
9	you try	to find out?
10	А	So I made contact with the manager over there, inquired
11	about th	ne purchase, as well as any video surveillance.
12	Q	All right. And were you able to find the transaction
13	associa	ted with that particular receipt?
14	Α	We were.
15	Q	Did you have a photograph or something of the receipt
16	that you could bring to the store?	
17	Α	Correct. It was a photograph like the one you showed me.
18	Q	Okay. Was the person there able to verify that that was in
19	fact their store?	
20	Α	Yes.
21	Q	And then were they able to get you video surveillance?
22	Α	They were.
23	Q	And did you obtain that video surveillance?
24	А	I did.
25	Q	Okay. And then you submitted it with this case?

1	Α	Correct.
2	Q	Separate from the Foot Locker, was there other video
3	surveilla	ance that you obtained from the Galleria Mall?
4	Α	Correct. Yes.
5	Q	And where was that of?
6	Α	So in general, I guess we could say public area, not
7	specific	to a mall or specific to a store, but the corridor of the
8	mall, I obtained that surveillance.	
9	Q	All right. Are you familiar with that surveillance?
10	А	I am.
11	Q	Did you obtain and get copies of that surveillance?
12	А	l did.
13	Q	And did you submit it with this case?
14	Α	l did.
15	Q	Showing you State's Proposed Exhibit 149.
16		Are you familiar with portions or segments of that video
17	where y	ou found the individuals you were looking for walking
18	inside tl	ne mall?
19	А	Yes, sir.
20	Q	Is it safe to say there's a lot of video?
21	Α	Yes.
22	Q	But you were able to look at certain portions where
23	suspect	s were shown in the mall?
24	Α	Yes.
25	Ω	And they were at different camera angles?

1	Α	Multiple different camera angles.
2	Q	And this is a synopsis or kind of a condensed version of
3	the port	ons where the suspects are seen walking?
4	А	Yes.
5	Q	And are they fair and accurate copies of the originals that
6	you saw	?
7	Α	Yes.
8		MR. PESCI: Move for the admission of State's 149, Your
9	Honor.	
10		MR. YAMPOLSKY: No, objection.
11		MR. HELMICK: No objection.
12		THE COURT: That'll be admitted. Thank you.
13		[STATE'S EXHIBIT 149 ADMITTED]
14	BY MR.	PESCI:
15	Q	So we're going to take a second, we'll have to switch over
16	and there'll be a monitor to your left where you'll be able to see.	
17		Just one second.
18		So Detective, do we have here four different angles that
19	you obta	ained from the overall surveillance?
20	Α	Yes, sir.

10	black polo shirt, light-colored pants with a black backpack.	
11	Q All right. Now, kind of going back in time, when w	∕e talk
12	about the crash	
13	THE COURT: If I may, just for	
14	MR. PESCI: I'm sorry.	
15	THE COURT: the record. That video appears to	be the
16	food court area of the mall?	
17	THE WITNESS: That is correct, sir.	
18	THE COURT: Thank you.	
19	MR. PESCI: Thank you, Your Honor.	
20	BY MR. PESCI:	
21	Q So as you responded to that crash scene, was that	shirt
22	multicolored shirt something that you saw in the car the	
23	Mercedes?	
24	A Yes, that shirt was located on the back seat.	
25	O Okay And then speaking of the individual with the	e dark

1	black sh	nirt, this is now on to Camera Angle I'll get the name
2	after but Number 9.	
3		[Surveillance video playing]
4	BY MR	. PESCI:
5	Q	Did you also have information as far as one of the people
6	fleeing	from the scene wearing a black shirt?
7	А	That I don't recall.
8	Q	All right. You personally don't recall that.
9	А	l don't.
10	Q	Okay. But from the Foot Locker, you said you were able
11	to see that black shirt as well.	
12	А	Correct.
13	Q	And now Camera Angle 10.
14		[Surveillance video playing]
15		THE COURT: And 9 was just one of the upper walkway
16	areas of the mall?	
17		THE WITNESS: Correct. And 10 is an upper walkway as
18	well in front of Shoe Palace.	
19		MR. PESCI: Thank you, Your Honor.
20	BY MR. PESCI:	
21	Q	And Shoe Palace, was that something of note to you?
22	А	It was.
23	Q	And why was that?
24	Α	Because well after reviewing this video, it became of
25	note to	me.

1	Q	All right. During the search warrant of the Mercedes back
2	at the c	rime lab, was there anything of note from the Shoe Palace?
3	А	Not that I recall.
4	Q	And now is this video cut up in time because there was a
