

ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO ASSOCIATE COUNSEL

Amicus curiae American Civil Liberties Union of Nevada has filed a motion to associate attorney Arianna Marie Demas, of the American Civil Liberties Union Foundation, in this matter pursuant to SCR 42. Attached to the motion to associate Ms. Demas is a verified application, certificate of good standing from the State Bar of New York and a Supreme Court Rule 42 statement. The Rule 42 statement of the State Bar of Nevada indicates that neither Ms. Demas, nor any member of the American Civil Liberties Union Foundation, has previously applied to appear in Nevada courts. See SCR 42(6) (repeated appearances by any person or firm pursuant to this rule shall be cause for denial of a motion).

Cause appearing, we grant the motion. Ms. Demas shall be permitted to appear on behalf of amicus curiae American Civil Liberties Union of Nevada in this appeal. Nevada attorney Nicole C. Levy, of the American Civil Liberties Union of Nevada, shall be responsible for all matters presented by Ms. Demas in this matter. <u>See SCR 42(14)</u> (the active member of the State Bar of Nevada who is attorney of record shall be present at all matters in open court); and NRAP 25(a)(5) (all documents submitted to the supreme court for filing by a represented party shall
