## **Motion for Extension of Time** to File a Petition for Rehearing

Pursuant to NRAP 26(b)(1)(A), appellant Devohn Marks moves for a 30-day extension of time to file a petition for rehearing in accordance with NRAP 40.

The Order of Affirmance was entered on March 17, 2022. Marks' petition for rehearing therefore is currently due by April 4, 2022. *See* NRAP 40(a)(1) (a petition for rehearing may be filed within 18 days after the filing of the appellate court's decision under Rule 36). If this motion is granted, the petition for rehearing would be due by May 4, 2022.

This is Marks' first request for an extension of time to file a petition for rehearing, and good cause exists for the extension.

## Good cause for granting an extension

Marks is incarcerated in High Desert State Prison in Indian Springs, Nevada.

He was sentenced on December 18, 2019 to an aggregate total sentence of 240 to

612 months (i.e., 20 to 51 years) in prison. In short, he is serving a very long

sentence that was just affirmed by this court.

Appellate counsel sent Marks a copy of the Order of Affirmance and a letter

explaining his options at this point. Most of our communication is by letter and it's

a slow process, since it takes time for letters to arrive, be read, and responded to.

Thus, appellate counsel needs more time to consult with Marks about the

Order of Affirmance, the grounds for seeking rehearing, and his postconviction

options. If Marks chooses to petition for rehearing, appellate counsel will need

additional time to review the briefs and appendix, and to research and write the

petition. Counsel cannot do all of this by April 4, 2022.

Therefore, Marks respectfully requests a 30-day extension of time of the due

date for filing a petition for rehearing: from April 4, 2022 to May 4, 2022.
