ORDER DENYING MOTION

This is a pro se appeal from an order granting a motion to enforce a settlement and dismissing appellant's complaint. Appellant has filed a motion requesting the appointment of appellate counsel. There is no Sixth Amendment right to appointed counsel in civil proceedings, and appellant has not demonstrated that the appointment of counsel is otherwise warranted in this case. *See Rodriguez v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court*, 120 Nev. 798, 102 P.3d 41 (2004). Accordingly, the motion is denied.
