ORDER REGARDING MOTION

Appellant has filed a motion for an indefinite extension of time presumably to file an informal opening brief, for the appointment of appellate counsel, and for copies of all the documents in this appeal. The request for an extension of time is granted. Appellant's informal opening brief was filed on October 9, 2020. Respondent need not file an answering brief unless directed to do so by this court. NRAP 46A(c).

There is no Sixth Amendment right to appointed counsel in civil proceedings, and appellant has not demonstrated that the appointment of counsel is otherwise warranted in this case. *See Rodriguez v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court*, 120 Nev. 798, 102 P.3d 41 (2004). Accordingly, appellant's request for the appointment of counsel is denied.

Finally, all documents in this appeal are available on the court's public portal website. The clerk of this court shall mail to appellant the sealed district court documents, pages 106-108 and 190-191, filed on March 2, 2020.
