Respondent/cross-appellant Fair Maps Nevada PAC has moved to dismiss this appeal and for sanctions on the ground that appellant/crossrespondent prevailed at trial and is therefore not aggrieved as required by NRAP 3A, and on the ground that NRS 295.061(3) prohibits an appeal from the district court's order. Fair Maps further contends that appellant/crossrespondent is engaging in delaying tactics to prevent respondents from moving ahead with the petition in time for the election, and they seek sanctions. Appellant/cross-respondent opposes the motion, and Fair Maps has filed a reply.

Having considered the arguments of the parties, this court denies the motion to dismiss and for sanctions. The appeal may proceed. Fair Maps may move this court to set an expedited briefing schedule as it deems warranted.

It is so ORDERED.
