SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE STATUS REPORT



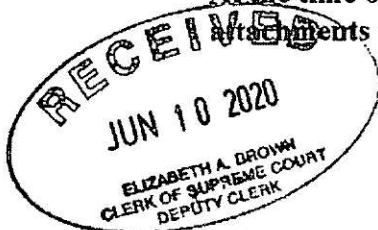
