Appellant Wilburt Hickman submitted his Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (post-conviction relief) on March 25, 2016. Appellant Wilburt Hickman submitted his Supplemental Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction) on April 28, 2017. Appellant Wilburt Hickman submitted a Supplement to Supplemental Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction) on June 14, 2018. The district court conducted an evidentiary hearing on September 27, 2019 on Appellant's claims. On January 13, 2020, the district court entered an Order denying his Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction). Appellant Wilburt Hickman appeals from this denial of Post-Conviction Relief.

Appellant Wilburt Hickman appeals the district court's order denying the claims raised in his supplemental petition for a writ of habeas corpus. Those claims are:

- 1. Whether the district court erred in denying Petitioner Wilburt Hickman's post-conviction petition for writ of habeas corpus where:
 - a. Trial counsel failed to conduct adequate investigation;
 - **b.** Trial counsel failed to investigate Mr. Hickman's mental health history; and
 - **c.** Failed to provide mitigating evidence of Mr. Hickman's serious history of mental health issues at sentencing.
