ORDER REGARDING ORAL ARGUMENT


The parties have filed a motion to conduct the oral argument in this matter remotely. Cause appearing, the motion is granted and the oral argument currently scheduled for December 15, 2021, at 11:30 a.m. will be videoconferenced. In addition, the parties shall each have 20 minutes for argument. Argument will be limited to a total of 40 minutes.

The court will use the BlueJeans videoconferencing system, which requires laptop/desktop/videoconferencing computer internet access and audio and video (web camera) capability. In case technical difficulties develop at any time, the court will conduct the oral argument by

teleconference, which will require counsel to have immediate access to a landline phone connection.

Within 5 days of the date of this order, the parties shall submit to the Clerk of the Court a notice identifying the attorney(s) who will argue the case and the phone number and email address of the attorney(s). The notice may be emailed to the court at nvscclerk@nvcourts.nv.gov.
