

ORDER

On January 7, 2021, this court directed counsel of record for appellants David J. Mitchell; Las Vegas Land Partners, LLC; Meyer Property Ltd.; Zoe Property, LLC; Leah Property, LLC; Wink One, LLC; Aquarius Owner, LLC; LVLP Holdings, LLC; and Live Works Tic Successor, LLC to respond and inform this court whether he also represents appellant Liberman Holdings, LLC. Attorney H. Stan Johnson has responded and informs this court that neither he nor his law firm represent Liberman Holdings. Accordingly, the clerk shall remove James L. Edwards, Kevin M. Johnson, H. Stan Johnson, and Cohen Johnson Parker Edwards as counsel of record for Liberman Holdings, LLC.

It appears that, while appellants Barnet Liberman and Casino Coolidge LLC are represented by Eliot Blut of Blut Law Group, appellant Liberman Holdings, LLC, is currently appearing without counsel. Liberman Holdings is cautioned that business entities may not appear or

file documents without counsel. NRAP 46A(b)(2); *Salman v. Newell*, 110 Nev. 1333, 1336, 885 P.2d 607, 608 (1994); *State v. Stu's Bail Bonds*, 115 Nev. 436, 436 n.1, 991 P.2d 469, 470 n.1 (1999). Accordingly, Liberman Holdings shall have 21 days from the date of this order to retain counsel and cause counsel to enter an appearance in this appeal. Failure of Liberman Holdings to retain new counsel will result in the dismissal of its appeal.

It is so ORDERED.
