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

20 **PLAINTIFF'S REPLY TO DEFENDANT'S OPPOSITION TO HER MOTION TO**
21 **RELOCATE**

22 DATE OF HEARING: November 20, 2019

23 TIME OF HEARING: 9:00 a.m.

24 COMES NOW Plaintiff, HEIDI MARIE PELKOLA ("Heidi"), by and through her
25 attorneys Radford J. Smith, Esq. and Kimberly Stutzman, Esq. of the firm Radford J. Smith,
26 Chartered, moves this Court for the following orders:
27
28

1 Defendant's Countermotion by reference as if fully restated herein. She also incorporates
2 by reference her Pre-Trial Memorandum filed October 1, 2019.
3

4 Furthermore, the facts and circumstances of this case are set forth in Heidi's
5 Unsworn Declaration which is included herein for convenience:
6

7 I, HEIDI PELKOLA, being duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

8 1. I make this Declaration based upon facts within my own knowledge, save
9 and except as to matters alleged upon information and belief and, as to those matters, I
10 believe them to be true. I have personal knowledge of the facts contained herein, and I am
11 competent to testify thereto.
12

13
14 2. The Defendant in this action is my former husband Greg Pelkola ("Greg"). I
15 have reviewed DEFENDANT'S OPPOSITION TO PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO
16 RELOCATE filed October 22, 2019 ("Opposition"), and I submit this Declaration in support
17 of my Reply to that Opposition.
18

19
20 3. Greg commences his Opposition with an incomplete, misleading and outright
21 false recitation of the history of this case. Though I am advised that no facts preceding that
22 most recent custodial order are admissible for the purposes of the change of custody, Greg
23 apparently seeks by his Opposition, I will address a few of the false statements in Greg's
24 motion that pertain to the custodial order.
25

26
27 4. Greg states in his Opposition that the party attended the settlement conference
28 that was set for March 6, 2014. That statement is false. The Court directed us to attend the

1 conference, and on the scheduled date I was present; *Greg never showed up*. I even called
2 Greg from the court area to try to get him to attend. There ultimately was no conference
3 because Greg failed to follow the Court's order. His claim that he was sick or that he
4 believed we were going to reconcile is false – he simply refused to attend. Greg further
5 suggests that Judge Elliott was unfair to him and refused to accept his filing of an Answer
6 to the Complaint. That statement is misleading at best.
7

8
9
10 5. Greg had multiple chances and substantial time to file an Answer. At a
11 hearing before the trial, Judge Elliot specifically told him that he had to file an Answer.
12 Greg refused to follow the direction of the Judge. Greg never timely appealed or otherwise
13 challenged the Decree even though he had knowledge of the Decree and had the financial
14 resources to do so.
15

16
17 6. Greg's claim that I "absconded with the children" is false; Greg always knew
18 where we were. I returned to Nevada and properly filed a Motion to relocate in January
19 2014. I had limited funds, and no family in Nevada, so I had no other option at the time
20 other than residing in the marital home until court approved my Motion to Relocate.
21

22 7. The court granted my motion to relocate, and I moved to Florida. I could not
23 remain in Florida because I did not have sufficient funds to do so. At that time, I was not
24 receiving any child support yet because it took longer than expected to process. I relocated to
25 Arizona in part because it would reduce the travel costs, so I would have more child support
26
27
28

1 to meet the expenses of the children. That fact is evidenced by the motion I filed on March
2 3, 2015.

3
4 8. The December 2017 hearing referenced by Greg was heard by Senior Judge
5 Kathy Hardcastle, who sat in for Judge Elliott. The issues addressed at the hearing
6 included Greg's alcohol abuse, allowing the children to use firearms, and a serious bite
7 my son suffered at the hands of the dog that Greg still owned. I raised these concerns as
8 part of a motion before Judge Elliott.
9
10

11 9. As a result of the evidence presented in that Motion, Judge Elliott limited
12 Greg to supervised visitation with the children. During those proceedings, I made it clear
13 to the Court that I believed that Sara, who was repeatedly reluctant to have visitation with
14 Greg, suffered from a form of autism.
15

16 10. Judge Hardcastle was a substitute for Judge Elliott on the date of the hearing.
17 I did not have enough money to hire counsel in part because Greg had violated the court's
18 Decree by failing to pay me a portion of his military retirement required under the decree,
19 and had taken active steps to prevent me from recovering anything (facts that were later
20 proven and found through later evidentiary hearings. Because I missed a deadline on
21 filing exhibits that I did not fully understand, the court struck all of my exhibits. Thus, I
22 was without the evidence that had caused Judge Elliott to limit Greg to supervised
23 visitation.
24
25
26
27
28

1 11. Judge Hardcastle dismissed any discussion of Sara's autism, a diagnosis
2 which has now been confirmed by counselors. While the findings written by Mr. Grimes
3 and signed by Judge Elliott, *not* Judge Hardcastle, included a quote from Judge Hardcastle
4 admonishing me regarding the expression of my concerns in the evidentiary hearing, there
5 is no reference anywhere in the "findings" to any specific behavior or facts that support
6 any allegation that I have alienated the children.
7

8
9 12. In fact, the only child who has regularly refused to go with Greg is Sara, and
10 I believe this has to do with Greg's ill treatment of her caused by his failure to recognize
11 her condition, or give any consideration that he should treat her differently that he treats
12 our other two children.
13
14

15 13. Greg has been involved in conferences via phone and only attended 1 IEP in
16 person. Although Greg was allowed extra time to come at the end of every month, but he
17 has only come 1 time since the last hearing approximately 7 months ago.
18

19 14. Next, I never claimed Justin Ritter lived in Hudson, Ohio. I stated Ohio. My
20 motion stated: "Heidi's fiancé, Justin Ritter, currently lives in Ohio and has lived there
21 since 2014." *See* Motion, page 3, line 22. Justin and I plan to each sell our respective
22 houses and purchase a new home in the Hudson, Ohio area.
23
24

25 15. In his Opposition, Greg used school statistics from Akron, Ohio, not Hudson
26 Ohio school district. This is in the Akron Public Schools district. Hudson is in the Hudson
27 City School District. He also claims that the court will need to evaluate Moon Valley in
28

1 Arizona, Garfield in Akron, and Cheyenne in Las Vegas. This is nonsensical. Again, I am
2 not moving to Akron, and the schools in Akron are in a separate school district with
3 different statistics, requirements, testing results, etc. If the court is inclined to review the
4 relocation, but denies the request, then I will continue to maintain primary custody in
5 Arizona. The court does not need to review schools in Las Vegas.
6
7

8 16. In his Opposition, Greg incorrectly claims that there are no Hopebridge
9 locations in Akron, Ohio. *See* Defendant's Opposition, page 6, line 14. Hopebridge, an
10 autism therapy center, has several locations. Though there is a location in Akron, Ohio,
11 located at 490 White Pond Dr, Akron, Ohio 44320, there is another location closer to
12 Hudson located in Cleveland, Ohio, which is approximately 30 minutes from Hudson.
13 Also, I do not intend to move to Akron, Ohio. I am confused as to why Greg continues to
14 reference Akron rather than Hudson.
15
16
17

18 17. Additionally, if I move, I have looked at jobs that would provide me with a
19 sign on bonus as a Licensed Practicing Nurse ("LPN"). I would also be able to help Justin
20 take care of all of our children.
21

22 18. If it is necessary to wait for the Court's approval to relocate to Hudson, Ohio,
23 (see my Opposition to Countermotion) Justin will take immediate steps to find a home and
24 start the purchasing process. There is currently a home that has been dropping in price that
25 both Justin and I want. *See* Photograph of 7897 Winterberry Drive, Hudson, Ohio, filed
26 with Exhibit "1." Also, as addressed in my motion, the cost of living in Ohio is
27
28

1 significantly less than the cost of living in Arizona. As a result, I will earn more, plus
2 Greg fails to acknowledge the additional sign on bonus.
3

4 19. In his Opposition, Greg claims that I am attempting to alienate or isolate him
5 from the children. This is false. He would have the same custodial time whether we reside
6 in Arizona or Ohio. I have even purchased gifts for the children to give to Greg at Father's
7 Day and other occasions. *See* Miscellaneous Photographs, including photographs Father's
8 Day Cards, gifts, filed as Exhibit "1."
9

10
11 20. Upon information and belief, Greg informed the children that he purchased a
12 home in Michigan, near Ontonagon, Michigan, where Greg was raised.
13

14 21. I, however, believe that Greg suffers from PTSD. Contrary to his opposition,
15 the Court did not find that the claims regarding his PTSD were untrue. This is also
16 nonsensical as the court cannot diagnose someone of PTSD. It is my understanding that
17 Greg was previously on medication such as "Celexa," which is used for mental health
18 issues, such as depression and anxiety. I, however, am not certain if he is still on Celexa.
19
20

21 22. Justin and I met in 6th grade. *See* Sixth Grade class photograph, filed with
22 Exhibit "1." We were friends throughout middle school and for the one-year in high
23 school until he moved. Justin and I will make more money in Hudson, Ohio. Justin makes
24 approximately \$72,000 per year in Ohio compared to the \$48,000 per year that he would
25 make in Arizona. Also, he will be unable to secure as much monthly overtime in Arizona
26 (4 hours) as he is able to secure in Ohio (20 hours).
27
28

1 (b) A GFDF *must* be filed in *support* of any opposition to a motion or
2 countermotion described in section (a).

3 [. . .]

4 (d) A financial disclosure *must be filed within 2 judicial days* of the filing
5 of the motion, *countermotion, or opposition it supports*, and may only be
6 filed in open court with leave of the judge upon a showing of excusable
7 delay.

8 [. . .]

9 (f) An assertion within a motion, opposition, or countermotion that there has
10 been no change in a financial disclosure *filed within the preceding 6 months*
11 satisfies this rule.

12 (g) The court may construe any motion, opposition, or countermotion *not*
13 supported by a timely, complete, and accurate financial disclosure as
14 *admitting that the positions asserted are not meritorious and cause for*
15 *entry of orders adverse to those positions, and as a basis for imposing*
16 *sanctions.*

17 [Emphasis added.]

18 Here, Greg filed his Opposition on October 22, 2019 (which was 21 days after
19 Heidi filed her Motion and therefore, untimely). Thus, his FDF should have been filed on
20 October 24, 2019. As of the date of this Reply, Greg has not filed an updated FDF since
21

1 *June 29, 2018.* For these reasons, Greg's request for attorney's fees and costs must be
2 denied.




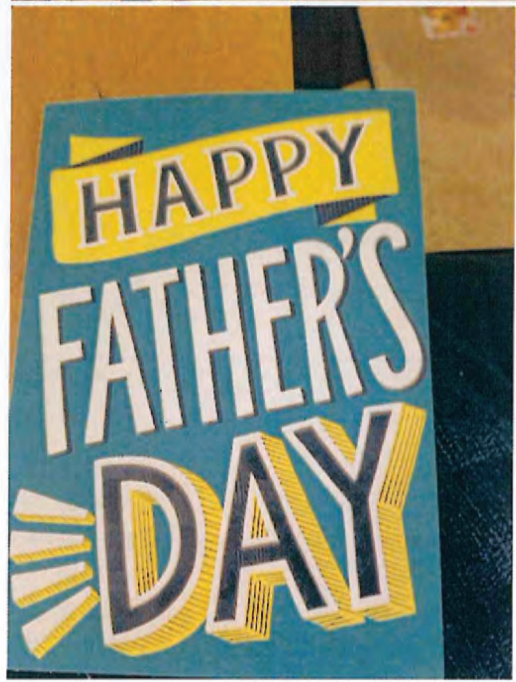



20 **ORDER REGARDING PLAINTIFF’S MEMORANDUM OF FEES, COSTS, AND**

24 Plaintiff, HEIDI MARIE PELKOLA (“Heidi”), filed her Memorandum of Fees,
25 Costs, and Disbursements on November 26, 2019 by and through her attorney of record,
26 Kimberly A. Stutzman, Esq. of Radford J. Smith, Chartered, Defendant, GREG
27 PELKOLA (“Greg”) not having filed a response, which was due on or before December 6,
28

1 2019, having reviewed the pleadings on file, and good cause therefore, the Court hereby
2 Finds and Orders as follows:
3

4 THE COURT HEREBY FINDS that on November 20, 2019, the Court directed
5 Heidi to submit her Memorandum of Fees and Costs (“Memorandum”). The Court further
6 directed that Greg shall submit his Objection within ten (10) days.
7

8 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that Defendant was required to file an Objection
9 to that Memorandum on or before Friday, December 6, 2019. As of the date of this
10 request, an Objection has not been filed or served on Plaintiff’s counsel.
11

12 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that Defendant’s failure to file an Objection
13 should be construed as an admission that the Plaintiff’s Memorandum of Fees and Costs is
14 meritorious and that he is consenting to the Court granting Heidi’s Memorandum in its
15 entirety.
16
17

18 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that Plaintiff incurred the following expenses:
19

1 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that Heidi requested that the Court enter an order
2 directing Defendant, Greg Pelkola to pay all of Heidi's reasonable attorney's fees and
3 costs that she has incurred relating to his Motions, including but not limited to his Motion
4 for An Order to Show Cause Why Plaintiff Should Not Be Held in Contempt and Motion
5 to Modify Custody and subsequent litigation, filed June 5, 2018.
6
7

8 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that the parties were scheduled to attend an
9 Evidentiary Hearing on November 20, 2019, which was originally continued from July
10 and then again from October. Greg, however, failed to provide documents to support his
11 request to modify custody. *See* Plaintiff's Motion in Limine, filed October 3, 2019. He
12 also failed to file and serve his Pre-Trial Memorandum or provide Heidi with any trial
13 exhibits. *Id.*
14
15

16 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that as a result, Heidi prepared for and was ready
17 to proceed to trial. Moreover, at the beginning of trial on November 20, 2019, Defendant
18 was late (arrived at 9:30 a.m.). Upon his arrival, he indicated that he was withdrawing his
19 Motion to Modify Child Custody. Heidi, however, had prepared for the trial, which was
20 originally scheduled for October.
21
22

23 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that at the hearing, Defendant claimed that he
24 provided Plaintiff with his Notice of Withdrawal in an email. This was false. Though
25 Defendant, through counsel, indicated that he intended to file the Withdrawal, Defendant
26 did not. Thus, Heidi was unaware of the withdrawal and still planned to proceed with trial.
27
28

1 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that Defendant's email was sent on Wednesday,
2 October 9, 2019. Though no Withdrawal was ever filed, the Evidentiary Hearing was
3 scheduled to commence on October 10, 2019. Thus, Plaintiff and her counsel had already
4 filed her Pre-Trial Memorandum, prepared her trial exhibits, and prepared for trial. For
5 these reasons, Greg unnecessarily multiplied these proceedings.
6
7

8 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that at the November 21, 2019 hearing,
9 Defendant admitted on the record that Heidi was the prevailing party.
10

11 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that there is no dispute that Heidi is the prevailing
12 party, and that she is entitled to an award of attorney's fees and costs.
13

14 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that the court directed Heidi to file a
15 Memorandum of Fees and Costs and directed Greg to file his objection within ten (10)
16 days.
17

18 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that Plaintiff requested that the Court grant her
19 request for attorney's fees and costs as outlined in her Memorandum.
20

21 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that a request for an order directing another party
22 to pay attorney's fees must be based upon statute, rule or contractual provision. *See, e.g.*
23 *Rowland v. Lepire*, 99 Nev. 308, 662 P.2d 1332 (1983).
24

25 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that NRS 18.010 states in relevant part –

- 26
27 1. The compensation of an attorney and counselor for his or her services is
28 governed by agreement, express or implied, which is not restrained by law.

1 2. In addition to the cases where an allowance is authorized by specific
2 statute, the court may make an allowance of attorney's fees to a prevailing
3 party:

- 4 (a) When the prevailing party has not recovered more than \$20,000; or
- 5 (b) Without regard to the recovery sought, when the court finds that
6 the claim, counterclaim, cross-claim or third-party complaint or
7 defense of the opposing party was brought or maintained without
8 reasonable ground or to harass the prevailing party. The court shall
9 liberally construe the provisions of this paragraph in favor of awarding
10 attorney's fees in all appropriate situations. It is the intent of the
11 Legislature that the court award attorney's fees pursuant to this
12 paragraph and impose sanctions pursuant to Rule 11 of the Nevada
13 Rules of Civil Procedure in all appropriate situations to punish for and
14 deter frivolous or vexatious claims and defenses because such claims
15 and defenses overburden limited judicial resources, hinder the timely
16 resolution of meritorious claims and increase the costs of engaging in
17 business and providing professional services to the public.

18 3. In awarding attorney's fees, the court may pronounce its decision on the
19 fees at the conclusion of the trial or special proceeding without written
20 motion and with or without presentation of additional evidence.

21 4. Subsections 2 and 3 do not apply to any action arising out of a written
22 instrument or agreement which entitles the prevailing party to an award of
23 reasonable attorney's fees.

24 NRS 18.010 [emphasis added]. In the instant matter, Heidi is the prevailing party.

25 Therefore, she should be awarded her fees and costs.

26 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that EDCR 7.60 states –

27 (a) If without just excuse or because of failure to give reasonable attention to
28 the matter, *no appearance is made* on behalf of a party on the call of a
calendar, *at the time set for the hearing of any matter*, at a pre-trial
conference, or on the date of trial, the court may order any one or more of the
following:

- (1) Payment by the delinquent attorney or party of costs, in such
amount as the court may fix, to the clerk or to the adverse party.
- (2) Payment by the delinquent attorney or party of the reasonable
expenses, including attorney's fees, to any aggrieved party.

1 (3) Dismissal of the complaint, cross-claim, counter-claim or motion
2 or the striking of the answer and entry of judgment by default, or the
3 granting of the motion.

4 (4) Any other action it deems appropriate, including, without
5 limitation, imposition of fines.

6 (b) The court may, after notice and an opportunity to be heard, impose upon
7 an attorney or a party any and all sanctions which may, under the facts of the
8 case, be reasonable, including the imposition of fines, costs or attorney's fees
9 when an attorney or a party without just cause:

10 (1) Presents to the court a motion or an opposition to a motion which
11 is obviously frivolous, unnecessary or unwarranted.

12 (2) *Fails to prepare for a presentation.*

13 (3) *So multiplies the proceedings in a case as to increase costs
14 unreasonably and vexatiously.*

15 (4) Fails or refuses to comply with these rules.

16 (5) Fails or refuses to comply with any order of a judge of the court.

17 [Emphasis added.]

18 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that in *Miller v. Wilfong*, 121 Nev. 619, 621, 119
19 P.3d 727, 730 (2005), the Court stated:

20 [I]t is within the trial court's discretion to determine the reasonable amount
21 of attorney fees under a statute or rule, in exercising that discretion, the court
22 must evaluate the factors set forth in *Brunzell v. Golden Gate National Bank*,
23 85 Nev. 345, 349, 455 P.2d 31, 33 (1969). Under *Brunzell*, when courts
24 determine the appropriate fee to award in civil cases, they must consider
25 various factors, including the qualities of the advocate, the character and
26 difficulty of the work performed, the work actually performed by the
27 attorney, and the result obtained. We take this opportunity to clarify our
28 jurisprudence in family law cases to require trial courts to evaluate
the *Brunzell* factors when deciding attorney fee awards. Additionally,
in *Wright v. Osburn*, this court stated that family law trial courts must also
consider the disparity in income of the parties when awarding fees.
Therefore, parties seeking attorney fees in family law cases must support
their fee request with affidavits or other evidence that meets the factors
in *Brunzell* and *Wright*.

Miller v. Wilfong, 121 Nev. 619, 623-24, 119 P.3d 727, 730 (2005).

1 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that Heidi seeks reimbursement of attorney's fees
2 in this matter for having to defend and litigate this matter as a result of Greg's Motion to
3 Modify Custody as the prevailing party and under the criteria set forth in *Miller v.*
4 *Wilfong*, 121 Nev. 619, 119 P.3d 727 (2005).

5
6
7 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that with regard to fees, the Supreme Court has
8 adopted "well known basic elements," which in addition to hourly time schedules kept by
9 the attorney, are to be considered in determining the reasonable value of an attorney's
10 services qualities, commonly referred to as the *Brunzell* factors.¹

11
12 1. *Quality of the Advocate*: his ability, his training, education, experience,
13 professional standing and skill. This factor logically addresses the rate at which counsel
14 charges for services. A skilled and experienced attorney can justify an hourly rate greater
15 than an attorney with less skill and experience. A party may contend that a rate is either
16 reasonable or excessive in the market based upon the education, skill and experience of an
17 attorney, or lack thereof.

18
19
20
21 Radford J. Smith, Chartered, is A/V rated firm. The attorneys have litigated almost
22 every aspect of Nevada family law during the course of their respective careers. Its senior
23 attorney, and the lead attorney in the present case, Radford J. Smith, Esq. has practiced
24 family law for over 30 years, and is a Nevada Board Certified Family Law Specialist. He
25 has written and lectured extensively in the field of Family Law for the National Business
26

1 Institute and the State Bar of Nevada, including a yearly presentation at the “Advanced
2 Family Law Seminar” conducted at the end of each calendar year. Mr. Smith’s rate of
3 \$500 per hour is reasonable based on his experience and qualifications. His associate who
4 has worked on this matter, Kimberly A. Stutzman, Esq. is a graduate of the Golden Gate
5 University School of Law. She received a Specialization Certificate in Family Law and
6 Intellectual Property upon graduation. She has exclusively practiced family law in the
7 three years that she has been licensed in Nevada. She is also licensed in the state of
8 California. Her rate of \$300 per hour is reasonable based on her qualifications, experience
9 and quality of work performed in this matter.
10

13

14 2. *The Character of the Work to be Done* – its difficulty, its intricacy, its
15 importance, time and skill required, the responsibility imposed and the prominence and
16 character of the parties where they affect the importance of the litigation. The “character
17 of the work” goes to whether the fee charged was commensurate to the “difficulty,
18 intricacy and importance” of the issues raised. Heidi incurred the fees and costs addressed
19 above due to Greg’s motions and actions. Heidi’s counsel worked diligently to defend
20 against Greg’s Motions, prosecute her Oppositions and Countermotions, and prepare for
21 trial in this case.
22
23
24

25 3. *The Work Actually Performed by the Lawyer* – the skill, time and attention
26 given to the work. Heidi’s counsel submits that the work done in this case was performed
27

1 in a competent and professional matter. The fees incurred were commensurate to the
2 work performed. Attached here to as Exhibits "1" is the redacted bill history for fees and
3 costs incurred as a result of responding to Greg's Motion to Modify Custody and
4 subsequent litigation. The calculation of the fees incurred based off of the invoices is also
5 included with the Bill History. Also included herein is Unsworn Declaration of
6 undersigned counsel, Kimberly A. Stutzman, Esq.
7

8
9
10 4. *The Result:* Whether the attorney was successful and what benefits were derived.

11 The Court granted Heidi's Oppositions and Countermotions to confirm her Primary
12 Custody. Greg's Motions were ultimately withdrawn at the *commencement* of trial. The
13 results demonstrate a success on the merits of the case. As of the date of filing this
14 Memorandum of Fees and costs, Heidi has incurred approximately \$59,699.25 in
15 attorney's fees and costs (\$58,340 in fees and \$1,359.25 in costs). *See* Exhibit "1" to
16 Plaintiff's Memorandum of Fees and Costs, filed November 26, 2019.
17
18

19 THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's Memorandum of Fees,
20 Costs and Disbursements pursuant to the Court's direction at the November 20, 2019
21 Hearing, which was filed on November 26, 2019, is hereby GRANTED in its entirety.
22

24 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Greg shall pay attorney's fees and costs to Heidi
25 the amount of _____ dollars and ____ cents (\$
26 _____).

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-mentioned amount shall be
2 REDUCED TO JUDGMENT, shall accrue interest at the legal interest rate, and shall be
3 collectable by all legal means.
