

ORDER

This order amends AO-0020, which concerns access to appellate court facilities. Consistent with the guidelines issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and Governor Sisolak's Emergency Directives on July 27, 2021, all court employees and persons entering the Carson City and Las Vegas court buildings, regardless of their vaccination status, are required to wear masks that cover their noses and mouths in all areas, including offices and meeting rooms when they are not alone. Wearing face coverings/masks is in addition to the social distancing guidelines currently in effect. This order is effective immediately.

It is so ORDERED.
