

*ORDER*

This order amends AO-22, which concerns access to appellate court facilities. Consistent with Governor Sisolak's Emergency Directive on February 10, 2022, all court employees and persons entering the Carson City and Las Vegas court buildings are no longer required to wear masks provided that they are fully vaccinated. Employees and persons entering court facilities who are not fully vaccinated are required to wear masks that cover their noses and mouths in all areas, including offices and meeting rooms when they are not alone. This order is effective immediately.
