

*ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO STRIKE*

Respondent/cross-appellant (respondent) has filed a motion to strike appellants/cross-respondents' (appellants) notice of supplemental authorities on the basis that the filing exceeds the permissible scope of such a notice. Appellants oppose the motion. Having reviewed the notice, this court agrees that it is improper because it contains argument. *See* NRAP 31(e) ("The notice shall further state concisely and without argument the legal proposition for which each supplemental authority is cited."). Accordingly, the motion is granted. The clerk shall strike the notice of supplemental authorities filed on March 18, 2021. If deemed warranted, within 7 days of the date of this order, appellant may file a motion for leave to file a supplemental brief to address arguments made in the reply brief on cross-appeal regarding arguments not raised in the district court.

It is so ORDERED.
