Volume V first contains DNA testing information and results. These documents include the minor victim's name, as well identifying information about another suspect in the case including his name, date of birth, and social security number. The volume also contains medical records, specifically the sexual assault exam, of the minor victim. Medical records should be sealed under HIPPA and NRS 449.720.
