





*ORDER RECALLING REMITTITUR AND GRANTING MOTION TO
STAY ISSUANCE OF THE REMITTITUR*

Appellant/cross-respondent mailed a motion to stay issuance of the remittitur pending the filing of a petition for a writ of certiorari with the United States Supreme Court on August 8, 2022. The motion was filed on August 9, 2022. Prior to the motion being filed, the remittitur in this appeal issued on August 9, 2022. The motion is therefore construed as a motion to recall and stay issuance of the remittitur. Cause appearing, the motion is granted to the following extent. *See* NRAP 41(b). The clerk of this court shall recall the remittitur. Issuance of the remittitur is stayed until December 7, 2022. If the clerk of this court receives written notice by December 7, 2022, from the clerk of the United States Supreme Court that appellant/cross-respondent has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari, the stay shall continue in effect until final disposition of the certiorari proceedings. If such notice is not received by December 7, 2022, the clerk shall issue the remittitur.

It is so ORDERED.
