*ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE*

This is an appeal from a district court order denying a petition for review of a decision of the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada. Initial review of the docketing statement and documents before this court reveals a potential jurisdictional defect. A copy of a written, signed district court order is attached to appellant's notice of appeal. However, it does not appear that the order was entered by the district court; the order does not bear the file-stamp of the district court clerk and does not appear on the district court docket sheet. See NRCP 58(c) ("The filing with the clerk of a judgment signed by the court . . . , constitutes the entry of the judgment, and no judgment is effective for any purpose until it is entered."); *State, Div. of Child & Family Servs. v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court*, 120 Nev. 445, 454, 92 P.3d 1239, 1245 (2004) ("[D]ispositional court orders that are not administrative in nature, but deal with the procedural posture or merits of the underlying controversy, must be written, signed, and filed before they become effective.").

Accordingly, appellant shall have 30 days from the date of this order to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. In responding to this order, in addition to points and

authorities, appellant should provide a file-stamped copy of the order it seeks to appeal. Respondent may file any reply within 14 days of service of appellant's response. Failure to demonstrate that this court has jurisdiction may result in the dismissal of this appeal. The deadlines for filing documents in this appeal are suspended pending further order of this court.

It is so ORDERED.
