



ORDER GRANTING MOTION

Appellant has filed a motion requesting a second extension of time to file the opening brief and appendix. Respondent Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (PUCN) has filed an opposition.¹ Having considered these filings, the motion is granted. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). Appellant shall have until November 30, 2020, to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. No further extensions of time shall be permitted absent demonstration of extraordinary circumstances and extreme need. *Id.* Counsel's caseload normally will not be deemed such a circumstance. *Cf. Varnum v. Grady*, 90 Nev. 374, 528 P.2d 1027 (1974). PUCN's request that this appeal be dismissed is denied.

It is so ORDERED.
