



ORDER REGARDING FACE COVERINGS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING AT THE 10TH
JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT

This Order supplements previous administrative orders out of this Court which restrict in-person access to the 10th Judicial District Court during the COVID-19 pandemic. The court has since issued internal guidelines that require all court employees to wear face coverings and follow CDC social-distancing when in the district court buildings. Consistent with these guidelines and those issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), and in order to protect public and employee health and safety, it is hereby ORDERED that anyone in a public area of the Tenth Judicial District courthouse shall wear a mask that covers his or her nose and mouth, except when necessary to remove the mask to be heard, and follow all CDC-compliant social distancing.

This order shall remain in place until amended or withdrawn.
