24 25 SPARKS JUSTICE COURT'S RESPONSE TO ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2020-2 CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19)

WHEREAS, the Chief Judge of the Sparks Justice Court has the authority pursuant to NRS 4.157(c) to make administrative decisions pertaining to the business of the Court;

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020, Governor Steve Sisolak declared a state of emergency in Nevada in response to the recent outbreak of the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19). Given the severity of the risk posed to the public by COVID-19, the Chief Judge of the Sparks Justice Court has determined that alterations to court procedure are necessary for the protection of the community; and

WHEREAS additional precautions are required to protect the general public and members of the Court staff,

And good cause being shown,

IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE MATTER OF:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED effective March 23, 2020, the lobby of Sparks Justice Court shall be closed to the public. Court operations will continue. Admittance into the courthouse is restricted to parties and attorneys who are specifically authorized to enter the Court on a case-by-case basis. Members of the public who wish to enter the Court must make a specific request by calling 775-353-7600.
