City of Las Vegas Charter 4.020(4.) charges the Chief Judge of the Las Vegas Municipal Court with establishing and enforcing administrative regulations for the governing of the affairs of the Municipal Court.

On March 12, 2020, Governor Steve Sisolak declared a state of emergency in Nevada in response to the recent outbreak of the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19). On March 17, 2020, the City of Las Vegas initiated the emergency continuity of operations (COOP). Given the severity of the risk posed to the public by COVID-19, the Chief Judge of Las Vegas Municipal Court has determined that alterations to court procedure are necessary for the protection of the community.

Effective March 18, 2020, Municipal court has set forth the following procedures to continue operating and managing cases within the parameters set forth in this order for the period of March 18, 2020, though and including, May 31, 2020

 Las Vegas Detention Center requests for release on own recognizance for medical reasons will be granted until futher notice The Defendant will be given a date to return in 60 days from date of release.

This Order shall be reviewed no later than every 30-days and shall continue until modified and/or rescinded by a subsequent order.
