WHEREAS, JCRLV 6.5 allows the Chief Judge to make "such orders as deemed  
advisable" relating to local court rules and procedure; and

WHEREAS, the Clark County Local Mitigation and Enforcement Plan expires on June  
1, 2021 at which time Clark County will return to pre-pandemic guidelines; and

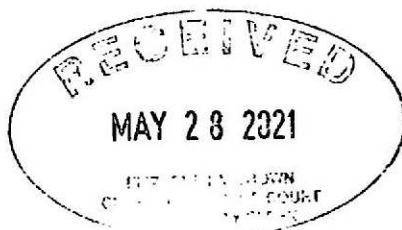
WHEREAS, Center for Disease Control, State, and County guidance on masks allows  
fully-vaccinated people to stop wearing face coverings in crowds and in many indoor locations,  
including County facilities; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Administrative Order #20-13 and Administrative  
Order #20-14 are now rescinded in their entirety effective immediately; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Las Vegas Justice Court comply with masking  
guidance consistent with the CDC, State, and County for fully-vaccinated individuals.
