MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

I. Procedural History

This appeal stems from the District Court's March 4, 2021 Order Denying Appellants' Anti-SLAPP Motion to Dismiss. Appellants filed a Notice of Appeal on March 31, 2020, and Appellants' Opening Brief was submitted on July 22, 2021.

II. Nevada Law Permits Motions to Extend Time

The Nevada Supreme Court may grant a motion seeking an extension of time to file a brief upon a showing of good cause. NRAP 31(b)(3). Good cause exists to grant Respondents a two-week extension to submit their answering brief due to scheduling conflicts, out of state travel and an unanticipated absence of support staff due to illness.

On August 13, 2021 the Clerk of the Supreme Court granted Respondents' telephonic request pursuant to NRAP 26(b)(1)(B) granting Respondents until September 7, 2021 to file the answering brief, which was originally due on August 23, 2021. Respondents' answering brief is currently due on September 7, 2021. This is Respondents' first written request pursuant to NRAP 31(b)(3). No prior requests have been denied.

As set forth within the declaration of counsel attached hereto, good cause exists to extend time because counsel has been preparing for trial in two cases: Outlaws Investment Group, LLC vs. Rockstar Investment Group, LLC, Case No. A-

15-728921-C, which was set for trial on September 7, 2021, but has since been continued, as well as Donna Carlson v. Sam's West, Inc. Case No. 2:17-cv-02882-MMD-GWF, which is currently set for trial in the U.S. District Court on October 18, 2021. In addition, undersigned counsel was absent from the jurisdiction from August 21, 2021 to August 25, 2021 to attend the deposition of a client in New Jersey. Finally, several staff members have missed work pending negative test results following potential COVID-19 exposure with two paralegals missing more than two weeks of work. The above situations came together at a time which made it difficult to adequately prepare Respondents' brief.

Further, Appellants did not comply with NRAP 30, and submitted an appendix without meeting and conferring in an attempt to reach an agreement concerning a possible joint appendix, thus requiring Respondents to spend additional, unnecessary time preparing a separate appendix.

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III. Conclusion

As set forth herein, Respondents respectfully request a two-week extension, allowing Respondents until September 21, 2021 to submit the answering brief.
