*ORDER GRANTING MOTION AND REJECTING OPENING BRIEF*

Appellant shall have 21 days from the date of this order to file and serve an opening brief that does not exceed 30 pages or the equivalent type-volume limitation. *See* NRAP 32(a)(7)(A).
