

ORDER REGARDING MOTIONS

Appellant's pro se motion for a second extension of time to file the opening brief is granted. NRAP 31(b)(3). The clerk shall file the opening brief received on October 23, 2020. Respondent need not file a response to the brief filed by appellant, unless ordered to do so by this court. NRAP 46A(c). This court generally will not grant relief without providing an opportunity to file a response. *Id.*

Appellant's pro se motion for leave to file an opening brief in excess of the page limitation is unnecessary where appellant represents that the brief complies with the type-volume limitation of NRAP 32(a)(7)(A)(ii). *See* NRAP 32(a)(7). Thus, no action will be taken on that motion.
