The violation of attorney-client communications has been noted in court transcripts from April 20-46862

1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 sentencing hearing, and the supplemental pre sentence investigation report dated March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020. It shall be brought to the courts attention that ("page Seven" "7") of the report discloses the failure to communicate with defendant in custody or appointed Attorney Carl Arnold. Attorney Arnold was not present at sentencing and has failed to respond to any further communications by Defendant Crawley.

The adjudication resulted in a decision that was based on unreasonable determination of the facts in light of the evidence presented by defendant prior to April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 Sentencing, Violating NRS 176.145, NRS 213.10988 Blankenship VS. State ; and NRS 202.350 in regards to Bradvica VS. State.
