DECLARATION OF AUDREY M. CONWAY

- 1. I am an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Nevada; I am a chief deputy public defender assigned to handle the appeal of this matter; I am familiar with the procedural history of this case.
- 2. On April 24, 2020, appellant filed a Notice of Appeal from the judgment of conviction in his jury trial; the reply brief in this appeal is due today. On November 24, 2020, the trial court granted a post-conviction motion from the State and changed Donko's aggregate sentence to reflect an increase to 168-438 months from the original aggregate sentence of 144-378 months. As of the filing of the Opening Brief and the State's Answering Brief, no amended judgment of conviction had been filed reflecting the post-conviction ruling. However, on May 25, 2021, an amended judgment of conviction was filed in the district court.
- 3. On June 1, 2021, Mr. Donko filed a Notice of Appeal from the Amended Judgment of Conviction filed on May 25, 2021. The second appeal has yet to be assigned a case number by this Court. Upon assignment of a case number, counsel will immediately file a motion to consolidate the appeal of the Amended Judgment of Conviction filed on May 25, 2021, with the current appeal of his judgment of conviction in the instant case, Supreme Court Case No. 81075. These appellate issues are intertwined, and the

change in aggregate sentencing has already been substantively briefed and

addressed by both parties in the instant appeal. In the interests of judicial

economy and in fairness to the defendant, Donko will seek consolidation of

these appeals to insure the proper preservation of all issues arising from the

Amended Judgment of Conviction filed on May 25, 2021.

4. This request for extension of time is made in good faith and not for

the purposes of delay. It is the best professional judgment of the undersigned

that this extension is crucial to the perfection of this appeal and to the

provision of effective assistance of counsel to this client.
