The court having reviewed the pleadings and papers on file herein including the Pre-Trial Memorandums filed by the parties prior to Trial, after considering and weighing the credibility of the witness and the exhibits admitted into evidence, and after further considering the closing arguments of counsel, and good cause appearing, the Court made Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Orders filed on or about January 23, 2020, which included, but not limited, to the following:

> IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff is entitled to additional fees not previously awarded. Counsel for Plaintiff shall submit a Memorandum of Fees and Costs for the additional amount. Counsel for Defendant, Mr. Mills, shall have an opportunity to file an objection.

The Court having considered the Defendant's, Caterina Memorandum of Fees and Costs filed on or about November 25, 2019, the Plaintiff's Opposition thereto filed on or about December 4, 2019, and the Defendant's Reply filed on or about December 16, 2019, and good cause appearing, an award of attorneys' fees and cost is reasonable based on NRS 125,150(4), NRS 125,040, NRS 18,010, Hornwood v. Smith's Food King, 105

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Nev. 188, 192, 772 P.2d 1284 (1989) (quoting Women's Federal S & L Ass'n. v. Nevada Nat. Bank, 623 F.Supp. 469, 470 (D.Nev. 1985), and the Brunzell factors. Pursuant to Brunzell v. Golden Gate Nat'l Bank, 85 Nev. 345 (1969), the Court has taken into consideration the following factors in determining the award of attorneys' fees: (1) The qualities of the advocate(s): Ms. Webster has been practicing law for 34 years and Ms. Lambertsen has been practicing law for 14 years; the law firm's practice is dedicated to family law. (2) The character and difficulty of the work performed: The intricacy, importance, time and skill required to prepare the papers, pleadings, attend the hearings and prepare and perform an Evidentiary Hearing in this case between July 19, 2019, through October 21, 2019 is moderate too difficult. (3) The work actually performed by the attorneys 13 and paralegals: between July 19, 2019 through October 21, 2019, approximately 125.3 hours were spent by counsel and 9.7 hours were spent by the paralegals, (4) The result obtained was favorable to the Plaintiff, Caterina Byrd, on a number of issues.
