MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANSWERING BRIEF

Respondents National Union Fire Insurance Company of Pitts-

burgh, PA. and Roof Deck Entertainment, LLC d/b/a Marquee Nightclub request an extension through August 2, 2021 to file the answering brief. NRAP 31(b)(3). This is the third such motion. The brief was extended once by stipulation and then by motion through July 1, 2021.

Extraordinary circumstances have created an extreme need for this extension. The attorney primarily responsible for the preparation of the answering brief fell suddenly ill and had to be on bed rest. In addition, counsel had expended time reviewing and addressing respondent Aspen Specialty Insurance Company's position, which was ultimately rendered unnecessary by the order removing Aspen from the caption.

Given the significant amounts at stake in this appeal, counsel request the extension to give the client that opportunity to review and approve the final brief before filing. Counsel will make every effort to finalize these revisions as soon as possible so as not to delay the proceedings.

Respondents also note that appellant's counsel had 145 days from the date the briefing schedule was reinstated to the actual filing of the opening brief.
