Appellant Airbnb, Inc. hereby files its limited opposition to Respondents' Eric Rice and Jefferson Temple as special administrator of the estate of Raheem Rice Motion for Extension to File Answering Brief.

Appellant filed its opening brief on March 1, 2021, and Respondents Answering Brief was due on March 31, 2021. Rather than file its Answering Brief, Respondents requested an extension of 60 days to file the brief, which this Court granted on April 15, 2021. Appellant did not oppose that first request for an extension. On June 1, 2021, Respondents filed a second request for extension, asking this court for an additional 45 days to respond. Appellant again did not oppose that second request for extension, and this Court granted the request on June 10, 2021.

On July 19, 2021, Respondents filed a third request for extension, seeking until July 30, 2021 to file their Answering Brief. While the expressed basis for the relief likely does not meet the criteria for "extraordinary circumstances," especially in light of the two prior extensions granting Respondents 108 extra days to file their Answering Brief, Appellant does not object to the extension. However, Appellant requests that this Court order that no additional extensions will be provided, and that if the Answering Brief is not filed by the deadline, that the case will be submitted solely on Appellant's Opening Brief and treated as unopposed. Appellant also requests that this Court grant it 60 days to file a Reply Brief to accommodate

schedules of counsel and to provide additional time to respond to the Answering Brief that Respondents have had over four months to draft.
