ORDER DENYING MOTION

This is an appeal from a district court order denying a motion to set aside a decree of divorce. Appellant has filed a motion for a stay or injunction pending appeal. A party must ordinarily move for a stay or injunction in the district court in the first instance. NRAP 8(a)(1)(A), (2)(A). Having considered the motion, opposition, and reply, this court is not convinced that moving for a stay or injunction in the district court in the first instance is impracticable. Accordingly, the motion is denied without prejudice. Appellant's request for a temporary stay or injunction and respondent's request for attorney fees and costs are also denied.
