ORDER REGARDING ORAL ARGUMENT

Oral argument in this matter is currently scheduled for December 15, 2021, at 2:00 p.m. in Carson City. Given the inclement weather in Carson City and health concerns related to the pandemic, counsel may appear in person in the Carson City or Las Vegas courtroom or by videoconference.
